SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1798, L. D. 1374, Bill "An Act for the Assessment of a State Tax for the Year Nineteen Hundred Fifty-one and for the Year Nineteen Hundred Fifty-two."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 5 thereof the following paragraph:

'The sum so collected for the year 1952 from each township and each lot or parcel of land not included in any township in the state shall be disbursed by the treasurer of state to each township and each lot or parcel of land not included in any township which are assessed for school or highway purposes in an amount not to exceed $\frac{3}{4}$ of the amount assessed for school and highway purposes and shall be credited to such purposes.'
