HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 581, L. D. 1388, "Resolve, Providing for the Payment of Certain Pauper Claims."

Amend said Resolve by adding at the end thereof the following: 'and be it further

<u>Resolved:</u> That the sums appropriated for the above-mentioned items shall be appropriated from the general fund; and be it further

<u>Resolved:</u> That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$316 from the appropriation for the state school for boys to be paid to Robert George Llewellyn, of South Portland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car which was taken by an escapee from the state school for boys; and be it further

<u>Resolved:</u> That chapter 100 of the resolves of 1951, heretofore passed by this legislature, is hereby repealed and shall not be printed as a part of the session laws of 1951.¹
