IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Several Academies, Institutes and Seminaries.

Appropriation for aid to academies. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the several academies, institutes and seminaries hereinafter listed the sum of \$25,000 from July 1, 1951 to June 30, 1952 and the sum of \$25,000 from July 1, 1952 to June 30, 1953, said sums to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said institutions to the amount indicated. These amounts are to be taken from the adjustment fund as provided by subsection II of section 106 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes:
