RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph T. Sewall, of Wiscasset.

Joseph T. Sewall; compensated. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,075.90 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Joseph T. Sewall, of Wiscasset, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for loss of business during the summer of 1949, caused by the change of location of a road; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

During the summer of 1949, the highway commission rebuilt Route #1 through Wiscasset. At the time of construction, the service station belonging to Mr. Sewall was practically forced out of business due to the fact that the surface of the yard was torn up and not replaced from June to October. The above claim is for loss of gas business to the amount of \$1,000 and loss of oil business to the amount of \$75.90.
