STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Jurisdiction Over Highways on Indian Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 20, § 20, amended. Section 20 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 20. Commission directed to include roads on Indian Island and in Indian Township in state highway system. The commission is directed to take over as a part of the state highway system all the roads on Indian Island, Penobscot county, in Pleasant Point and Indian Township in Washington county and the bridge between Indian Island and Old Town. Said roads and bridge may be reconstructed from time to time as in the judgment of the commission is necessary, and the expense thereof, except as otherwise provided in section 28, shall be paid from funds available for the construction of state highways.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 20, § 48, amended. Section 48 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 48. Maintenance of highways and bridges on Indian Island and in Indian Township. The Roads roads in Indian Township and bridge referred to in section 20 shall be maintained by the commission and the expense thereof charged to such funds under the jurisdiction of the commission as are available for the purpose of maintaining state highways.'
