SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 128, Resolve, Providing for
State Pension for Clyde Spaulding, of
Hartland.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 1st line the
figures "\$50" and inserting in place thereof the figures '\$30'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out in the
4th line the figures "1951" and inserting in place thereof
the figures '1953'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out the period
at the end thereof and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated
out of the appropriation for the department of health and
welfare the sum of \$360 for the fiscal year ending June 30,
1954 and \$360 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955 to
carry out the purposes of this resolve.'
