AN ACT Relating to Hunting Licenses for Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 33, § 63, sub-§ VI, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection VI of section 63 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘Any resident between the ages of 12 and ~~18~~ 16 years may hunt with firearms without a license if accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian while in the fields or forests or on the waters or ice of the state. Any resident between the ages of ~~12~~ 16 and 18 years may procure a license to hunt with firearms by filing with the clerk issuing the license the written consent of his parent or guardian.’
