RESOLVE, Naming the Myron H. Avery Peak of Mt. Bigelow.

Myron H. Avery Peak of Mt. Bigelow, named. Resolved: That the east peak of Mt. Bigelow, near Stratton in the county of Franklin, be hereafter officially named and referred to as "The Myron H. Avery Peak of Mt. Bigelow."

STATEMENT OF FACTS

It is the intent of this resolve to create a memorial to Myron H. Avery by naming the east peak of Mt. Bigelow for him. Mr. Avery, who passed away last summer, was a Maine native. For many years he was chairman of the Appalachian Trail Conference; and, more than any other man, was responsible for the construction and maintenance of Appalachian Trail.
