STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Marking of Moosehead Trail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1951, c. 165, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 165 of the private and special laws of 1951 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The state highway commission shall erect and maintain suitable signs designating the "Moosehead Trail."'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$200 to carry out the purposes of this act.
