AN ACT Relating to Requirements of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 154, § 23-A, additional. Chapter 154 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 23-A. Requirements of deeds. For an individual to execute an instrument under seal it shall be sufficient if the word "Seal" appears following his signature, and it shall henceforth not be required that an individual attach an adhesive substance thereto.'
