### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

Resolve in Favor of Robert W. Johnson, of Rumford.

Robert W. Johnson; to be given credit. Resolved: That Robert W. Johnson, of Rumford, be given credit for 2/3rd of a year of teaching service, or sufficient teaching service, to enable him to qualify for a disability benefit under the provisions of chapter 60 of the revised statutes.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Robert W. Johnson was educated in the public schools of Belfast and was graduated from Bowdoin college.

He has had approximately 9 1/3 years of educational experience in the public schools of Southwest Harbor and Rumford and in Freedom Academy. He is now permanently disabled with a serious illness.

To meet the provisions of the state employees retirement law, Mr. Johnson asks that 2/3rd of a year of teaching service be declared creditable so that he will have a total of 10 years of creditable service thus enabling him to meet the provisions of the law for a disability benefit.
