AN ACT Relating to Divesting Property in Qualifications for Old Age Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 22, § 265, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 265 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘Any applicant for or recipient of old age assistance, who divests himself directly or indirectly of any property without a reasonable consideration, **after January 1, 1952**, or for the purpose of qualifying for such assistance, shall forfeit all right to receive assistance under the provisions of sections 256 to 274, inclusive.’
