COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 36, L. D. 39, Bill "An Act
to Secure Uniformity of Assessment of
Forest Lands for Purposes of Taxation."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 157" by
striking out the underlined words "on the capital invested"
at the end of the 1st paragraph, and by striking out the
underlined figure "50" in the 2nd line of the 2nd paragraph
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '25'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the dollar
signs in the 2nd and 3rd lines of section 2 the figures
'30,000'
