RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Cushing.

Town of Cushing; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Cushing, the sum of \$5,000 from the unexpended surplus of the general fund, to aid said town in the completion and construction of the new three room school located at Broad Cove; and be it further

Resolved: That any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account for the same purpose.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A 3 room school has been built at Broad Cove and this money is needed to aid the town of Cushing in completing said construction.
