COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 44, L. D. 45, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Laws of Divorce."

Amend said bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
"R. S., c. 153, § 69, amended. Section 69 of chapter 153
of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding the
following paragraph at the end thereof:

'An original decree made pursuant to this section granting
the care and custody of a minor child to the department of
health and welfare shall not extend beyond the time when the
child shall reach the age of 18 years. But upon application
by the department, the court, for sufficient cause, may extend
such decree to the time when the child shall reach the age of
21 years.'"
