STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Total Incapacity Under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 26, § 11, amended. The 1st sentence of section 11 of chapter 26 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'While the incapacity for work resulting from the injury is total, the employer shall pay the injured employee a weekly compensation equal to 2/3 his average weekly wages, earnings or salary, but not more than \$24 \$36, nor less than \$12 a week; and in no case shall the period covered by such compensation be greater than 500 weeks from the date of the accident, nor the amount more than \$9,000.'
