STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Old Age Assistance and Aid to the Blind.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 260, amended. Section 260 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the 1st paragraph a new sentence to read as follows:

'Whenever the federal matching maximum is changed, the department may change the maximum grant with the approval of the governor and council.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 278-A, amended. Section 278-A of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 4 of chapter 44 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence to read as follows:

'Whenever the federal matching maximum is changed, the department may change the maximum grant with the approval of the governor and council.'
