STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to the Schoolhouse in Indian Township, Near Princeton.

Schoolhouse in Indian Township near Pleasant Point; jurisdiction of. Resolved: That the responsibility for the maintenance, repair and control of the old schoolhouse in Indian Township near Princeton, which is now in the jurisdiction of the department of education, be and hereby is transferred to the department of health and welfare.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time control of this building is in the department of education. It is not being used as a school. It is now used by the Indians as a church and control of it should be transferred to the department of health and welfare.
