#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a Salmon Rearing Station in Southern Maine.

Salmon rearing station authorized. Resolved: That the sum of \$200,000 be and hereby is appropriated to the department of inland fisheries and game from the general fund for the construction of a salmon rearing station, at a suitable point in southern Maine where proper waters are available, and be it further

**Resolved:** That any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

A salmon rearing station at Gorham is inoperative due to inability to obtain water. In order to stock salmon waters in southern Maine a rearing station is essential.
