STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing Appointment of Special Guardian.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 145, §29-A, additional. Chapter 145 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. Special guardian for minor or adult. Pending the appointment of a guardian for a minor or for an adult, the judge of probate, in his discretion, may, at any time and without notice, appoint a special guardian who shall have the same powers and perform the same duties as a guardian appointed under the provisions of this chapter.'
