**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Millinocket for Supplies Furnished
the Warren Dorr Family.**

Town of Millinocket; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$9,557.42 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Millinocket, to reimburse said town for supplies and medical aid furnished the Warren Dorr family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These supplies and medical aid were furnished the Warren Dorr family between 1932 and 1950 prior to definite pauper settlement.
