RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Porter Lake, Franklin County.

Fishing in Porter lake; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting fly fishing or trolling only, except bait casting permitted and fishing from shore with not more than 10 feet of line, in Porter lake, Franklin county, with a daily bag limit of 2 fish per person, either trout, togue or salmon.
