COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 80, L. D. 75, Bill, "An Act
Relating to the Town's Share in Aid
to Dependent Children."

Amend said Bill by adding the underlined word 'decennial'
after the underlined abbreviations "U. S." at the beginning
of the 12th line thereof.

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the 2nd
sentence of that part designated "Sec. 234" the following
underlined sentence:

'The population of those cities, towns and organized
plantations in which state institutions under the control of
the department of institutional service are located will be
decreased by the inmate of patient population of such institutions
as of April 1, 1950.'
