HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 80, L. D. 75, Bill, "An Act relating to the Town's Share in Aid to Dependent Children".

Amend said Bill by striking out all after the first sentence of Sec. 234 and substituting therefor the following underlined words:

The share of each city, town or organized plantation shall be determined by the ratio the total amount expended for aid to all dependent children whose legal settlement is in such city, town or organized plantation bears to the total amount expended for aid to all dependent children who have a legal settlement in any city, town or organized plantation in the state. The amount due from each such city, town or organized plantation shall be due when billed. Whenever a city, town or organized plantation is delinquent in making reimbursement to the state, the amount shall be collected by the state in the same manner and subject to the same penalties as state taxes. Any balance due shall be assessed in the succeeding year in the same manner as other state taxes.
