STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating fishing in Stearns Pond and Tributaries in the County of Oxford.

Fishing in Stearns pond and tributaries, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing the tributaries to Stearns pond in Sweden, in the county of Oxford, to the taking of smelts every other year and establishing a bag limit on Stearns pond of one bass per boat, to be taken by fly fishing only, during the month of June.
