RESOLVE, in Favor of Angelo Cote, of Augusta.

Angelo Cote; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$100 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the state liquor commission to be paid to Angelo Cote, of Augusta, to reimburse him for a retail malt liquor license issued to him and which he was unable to use because of sale of his business.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

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Mr. Cote, having sold his business, was unable to use his retail malt liquor license in 1953. The purpose of this resolve is to refund to Mr. Cote the \$100 he has paid for the license which he did not use.
