STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Moving Expenses of Fish and Game and Coastal Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 29-A, additional. Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Moving Expenses of Wardens

Sec. 29-A. Moving expenses of wardens. Whenever inland fish and game wardens or coastal wardens are transferred within and by their respective departments from one location to another for the benefit of public service, they may be entitled to transportation of household goods and effects not to exceed 6,000 pounds at the expense of the state.'
