STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Medway.

Town of Medway; appropriation for construction of school building. Resolved: That the sum of \$6,500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to be expended by the town of Medway toward the construction of a new school building in the town of Medway to furnish school privileges to the youth of Medway and nearby unorganized territory.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Medway schools furnish school privileges for state scholars from nearby unorganized territory, which causes an overcrowded condition in the grade schools.
