**RESOLVE, in Favor of Addition to Chemical Engineering Building at  
University of Maine.**

---

**Chemical Engineering Building; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$370,000 in favor of the University of Maine to construct and equip a pulp and paper wing to the chemical engineering building (Aubert Hall); and be it further

**Resolved:** That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This wing would be the second of 3 units of a chemical engineering building, the central portion of which was constructed in 1940. This addition is needed if the University is to maintain its high standing in pulp and paper instruction and research, and effectively serve Maine's largest industry.
