**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Bridgewater for Hospitalization
and Medical Aid for Robert Crockett.**

Town of Bridgewater; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$646.05 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Bridgewater, to reimburse said town for hospitalization and medical aid extended to Robert Crockett; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1938 Robert Crockett was taken sick in the town of Bridgewater and the amount of \$646.05 was expended by the town of Bridgewater for his care and medical aid. Before it was learned that his home town was Hallowell, the time had expired within which they should have been notified. The amount is still outstanding on the books of the town of Bridgewater and they are asking for reimbursement.
