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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Dragon Cement Company, Inc.**

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**Dragon Cement Company; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$801.45 to be paid to the Dragon Cement Company, Inc., as a full and final settlement of their claim against the state for refund of gasoline tax due them for the period from January 1, 1952 to October 31, 1952; said sum to be paid by the bureau of taxation.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Section 166 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes requires that applications for refunds must be filed with the state tax assessor within 9 months from the date of purchase. The company did not file its proper application for refund within the time allowed, and were technically barred. The bureau of taxation has proposed that a resolve be introduced to permit this refund.
