RESOLVE, Relating to Salary Increases to State Police Granted by Ninety-fifth Legislature.

Salary increases to state police granted by 95th legislature. Resolved: That the salary increases of the members of the state police, as provided by chapter 408 of the public laws of 1951, be made effective as of the week ending March 10, 1951; and be it further

Resolved: That there is hereby appropriated \$25,200 from the general highway fund and \$2,800 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The effective date for salary increases to state police, granted by chapter 408 of the public laws of 1951, was August 20, 1951. The effective date for salary increases to other state employees, granted by chapter 120 of the resolves of 1951, was the week ending March 10, 1951.

The purpose of this resolve is to correct the inequity thus created and to place the state police in the same status as other state employees.
