STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT to Enlarge the Old Town Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. That part of section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, which relates to Old Town Game Preserve, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Old Town Game Preserve: The following described territory situated in the city of Old Town, in the county of Penobscot; bounded by Stillwater avenue the Orono town line on the south, and Stillwater and Penobscot rivers on the west, north and east.'
