AN ACT Relating to Ballot Clerks in Small Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that in towns of not more than 300 inhabitants 2 clerks, each representing one of the two political parties which at the gubernatorial election preceding such appointment cast the greatest number of votes, shall be sufficient.'
