STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Authorizing City of Old Town to Use Certain Lands of State of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

City of Old Town authorized to use certain lands. Permission is hereby granted to the city of Old Town to use the land situated in the city of Old Town lying along the banks of the Penobscot river between the bridge to Indian Island and the Old Town shoe company, said land belonging to the state of Maine. Authority is hereby granted to said city of Old Town to use said land for free public parking of automobiles and to grade and fill said land suitable for such purpose.
