COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 112, L. D. 114, Bill "An Act
Relating to Accident Insurance for
Boxers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 8-A after the headnote thereof and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words:

'The Commission shall have the authority, in its discretion to make and promulgate rules requiring coverage by accident insurance in the event of injury or death for persons competing in properly licensed boring or sparring matches or erhibitions, as defined in this chapter. Such insurance, if required shall comply with standards prescribed by the insurance commissioner.
