STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Accident Insurance for Boxers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 78, § 8-A, additional. Chapter 78 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 8-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 8-A. Accident insurance for boxers. All boxers licensed as such under the provisions of this chapter shall be covered by accident insurance in the event of injury or death while competing in a properly licensed boxing or sparring match or exhibition. Such insurance shall be covered by a group policy to be issued by an insurance company authorized to do business in the state which policy shall first meet with the approval of the commission as to form, premium and coverage.'
