AN ACT Relating to State Stipend for Counties and Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 27, § 16, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 16 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'This stipend shall be divided among the legally incorporated agricultural clubs, societies, **counties, towns** and fair associations of the state, hereafter in this chapter designated as "societies," according to the following schedule and method.'
