AN ACT Relating to Refund on Retail Liquor Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, & 36, additional. Chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 36, to read as follows:

'Sec. 36. Retail liquor license refund. Any retail liquor licensee, executor or administrator if deceased or trustee or receiver if bankrupt may voluntarily surrender his license to the commission. The commission is hereby authorized to refund the fee therefor as follows: if surrendered within 6 months of the period for which the license was issued, the fee shall be pro rated. No refund shall be made for any license surrendered more than 6 months after issuance. No refund shall be made if at the time of surrender there is pending any action against the licensee for violation of the provisions of this chapter or any rule and regulation promulgated thereunder. If, on final determination of such action, the decision is in favor of the licensee, refund shall be made as herein provided; otherwise any refund due shall be forfeited.'
