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**AN ACT to Facilitate the Burning of Brush and Slash.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 32, § 68-A, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 68-A of chapter 32 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 363 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof, the following:

**‘Provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply except after the governor, upon recommendation of the forest commissioner, shall have declared the burning of brush or slash hazardous in the respective counties.’**
