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**AN ACT Relating to Refund of Gasoline Tax to Town of North Haven.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 20, § 107, sub-§ VIII, additional.** Section 107 of chapter 20 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding after subsection VII, a new subsection, to be numbered VIII, to read as follows:

**‘VIII. For returning and paying to the town of North Haven, Knox county, 5c per gallon upon internal combustion fuel sold in the town of North Haven, except that the amount of such fuel used in motor boats shall not be included. The amount so paid to the town of North Haven shall be used exclusively, under the supervision of the highway commission, to aid in constructing, repairing and maintaining public highways within the town.’**
