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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Indians at Peter Dana Point Reservation for  
Building and Repair of Homes.**

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**Indians at Peter Dana Point Reservation; appropriation for. Resolved:**  
That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$3,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1954, to be expended for the purpose of repairing existing homes and building new homes for the Indians of Peter Dana Point Reservation; these funds to be expended on authorization of the department of health and welfare.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The American Friends Service Committee has agreed to undertake a work project involving 15 to 20 adult persons at the Peter Dana Point Reservation during the summer of 1953. The appropriation requested in this resolve is for the purpose of supplying materials to be used in the repair of the homes. Those working on the project supply their own board and receive no compensation. The state will be required to supply the services of one carpenter to supervise the building work and also one painter.
