STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Hampden Academy.

Hampden academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Hampden academy, the sum of \$15,000 to be taken from the general fund of the state to complete construction of a gymnasium for said Hampden academy.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1951, \$15,000 was appropriated to build a gymnasium at Hampden academy and this \$15,000 is needed to complete the project. The gymnasium will provide an opportunity to make available to all the students of the academy a full program of physical education. It will also provide a much needed place for school assemblies, dramatics, etc.
