IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of John Morin of the Unorganized Township of Connor.

John Morin; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$300 from the state highway fund to be paid to John Morin of the unorganized township of Connor, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his land caused by the state changing the course of a stream on said land.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A crew of the state highway department, while working in the unorganized township of Connor, changed the course of a stream which crossed his land causing damage to the extent of \$300.
