STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Carelessly Shooting a Human Being While Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 125, amended. The 1st sentence of section 125 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whoever while on a hunting trip, or in the pursuit of wild game or game birds, negligently or carelessly shoots and wounds, or kills any human being, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 years by imprisonment for not less than 1 year nor more than 3 years.'
