STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Malt Liquor in Non-Returnable Bottles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 23-A, additional. Chapter 57 of the revsied statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 23-A. Non-returnable bottles. No malt liquor in bottles shall be sold except in bottles returnable by the purchaser for a refund of 10c, regardless of any wording on bottles or labels to the contrary. The provisions of this section shall not apply to malt liquor sold in bottles to be consumed on the premises.'
