### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Addition to Animal Science Building at University of Maine.

Building at University of Maine; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$330,000 in favor of the University of Maine to construct and equip an additional unit to the Animal Science Building; and be it further

Resolved: That this appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been completed.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

This addition would be the second unit of a 3-section building. The 1st section, the animal pathology laboratory, authorized by the 94th legislature, was constructed in 1950. The proposed unit will provide urgently needed classroom and added laboratory facilities for the diagnosis of poultry and animal diseases for students in animal industry, bacteriology, biochemistry, and poultry, and make space available in other buildings for the development of a more effective program of agriculture teaching and research.
