COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 70, L. D. 152, "An Act to
Facilitate Voting by Members of the
Armed Forces of the United States."

Amend said bill by striking out all of Section 5 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Ballots; delivery and receipt. All ballots cast
under the provisions of this chapter, whether delivered in
person or by mail, shall be received by the plantation, town or
city clerk before the closing of the polls on the day of
election. Any city or town clerk on receiving such a ballot
shall, if requested, give to the person delivering such ballot
a receipt setting forth the precise date, hour and minute of
delivery.'
