COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 69, L. D. 153, Bill "An Act  
Relating to Dogs Attacking Domestic  
Animals or Fowl."

Amend said bill by striking out the underlined sentence  
therein and inserting in place thereof the following under-  
lined sentence:

'Any owner of sheep or fowl or any member of his family  
or any person to whom is entrusted the custody of any sheep  
or fowl shall have a right to kill any dog attacking any of  
said sheep or fowl.'
