STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the Kittery Electric Light Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1905, c. 391, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 391 of the private and special laws of 1905, as amended by chapter 53 of the private and special laws of 1941, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. May hold necessary real and personal property. Said corporation, for said purpose, may hold all real and personal estate necessary and convenient therefor not exceeding \$500,000.'
